Dear Friend of Tibet,


I'm writing to express my wholehearted support for Team Highpoint and the "50 for Tibet" project. Since "50 for Tibet" began as a distinct volunteer-led effort in 2006, the team has raised approximately \$200,000 in donations for the International Campaign for Tibet's Rowell Fund. The Rowell Fund is an important part of our work because it allows ICT to nurture initiative and creativity in Tibetan communities with small grants that invoke the legacy of Barbara and Galen Rowell's passion for Tibet. Since its inception in 2003, the Rowell Fund has awarded over \$285,000 in grants to over 80 Tibetan grantees.

Since June of 2006, Team Highpoint has completed 48 of 50 highpoint climbs in the United States and has even completed a few extra expeditions over the years including the highpoints in Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland, England and Ireland. Later this year, they plan to climb Gannett Peak in Wyoming and peaks in Norway, Sweden, Finland and Denmark. Along the way, Team Highpoint has done an excellent job raising awareness of the Tibet issue with the media and individuals they've encountered while climbing. Their commitment to this issue and their dedication to the memory of Barbara and Galen Rowell is inspiring.
